- The student may be required to participate in interview with a member(s) of the school and/or a member of Lauren Eddleman's family.

### **Applicant Qualifications:**

The student must meet the following qualification in order to be considered as an applicant for the scholarship.

- A student in good standing at KDS DAR High School.
- **o** 3.0 GPA.
- ACT score of 22 or higher.
- o Student Need.
- Community Service.
- o School Service.
- Work Ethic.
- Plans for the future.
- An applicant should also detail any special circumstances that he/she feels that are pertinent and significant.

## **Scholarship Recipient:**

o The scholarship recipient is required to send correspondence to the Lauren Eddleman family in the form of a thank you card/letter as an acceptance of the Lauren Eddleman Scholarship. The correspondence must be sent to the following:

- o After being selected, the recipient of the scholarship is required to submit grades at the end of each quarter/semester. If the student does not maintain a 3.0 GPA, scholarship funds can be suspended.
- o Scholarship funds are distributed directly to the institution for which the student will be attending. Scholarship funds cannot be paid directly to the student.
- o The full amount of the scholarship must be utilized within the first 2 years of college once the student has graduated from KDS DAR High School. (Note: This time period will begin in the first fall after his/her graduation from high school). The amount of scholarship funds that are dispersed will be dependent upon the wishes of the Lauren Eddleman family.
